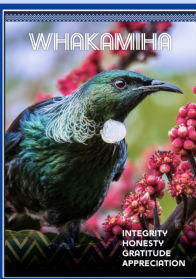


2026 Maeroa Intermediate Annual Plan - Overview

Annual Plan Initiatives

- Literacy and Maths Teams to develop and maximise in-school support in literacy and maths to support sustainable coaching and monitoring.
- Further development of explicit teaching practices across to include all teachers.
- Further development of the understanding of high-impact teaching strategies across all teachers.
- All teachers, regardless of curriculum area, will be explicitly integrating literacy and maths into their planning and teaching.
- Strengthen teacher knowledge of assessment tools and their alignment with the new Literacy and Maths Curriculum.

- Students receive the support they need to access learning, social, emotional, and behavioural support.
- 85% of students are involved in at least one extracurricular activity that supports their development and sense of belonging at Maeroa.
- The first year of the Mitey Programme's professional learning is delivered to all staff and intentionally included in weekly teaching plans.
- Promote culturally responsive practices and Te Ao Maori.

- Develop a targeted attendance plan to increase overall school attendance to 70%, up from 58% 2025.
- Develop and deliver a school communication plan to ensure all whaanau have the opportunity and choice to participate.
- Increase whaanau engagement at school events.
- Reporting to parents keeps whaanau informed about their child's learning.
